DRESS CODE – SENIOR YEARS 12 & 13

Students in Years 12 and 13 at Nayland College are not required to wear school uniform. The school respects individual difference and gives students the privilege and responsibility of managing themselves and making good decisions about what to wear.

The non-uniform dress code requires a standard of dress appropriate for our learning environment.

GENERAL

- Clothing should be clean, tidy and undamaged and must not offend others
- Logos and graphics must be appropriate e.g. not offensive nor promoting alcohol or illegal substances
- All underwear must be completely covered
- Appropriate footwear is to be worn at all times with closed-in shoes being required for workshops
- Any visible facial or body piercing must be subtle and discreet

BOYS

- Top-half garments must have sleeves
- Must be clean shaven

GIRLS

- Tops must have straps and these must be of a minimum of 3 cm wide
- Must have no visible cleavage or midriff
- Shorts, skirts and tops worn over tights must be long enough to reach the fingertips when arms are held straight at the sides with shoulders relaxed

There will be occasions where the dress expectation is more formal, e.g. senior prizegiving.

We encourage students to take pride in their appearance and ask that parents support the school by ensuring that their son/daughter maintains a clean, tidy and appropriate standard of dress.
